

BUILDING UPDATE

Dear Church Members

As most of you are aware, it may seem like the building project is at a standstill. Please be assured, your Building's Team is working hard to make things happen as soon as possible.

Over the last several weeks, we have the foundation pad in place and all the compaction tests have been completed and approved. We have given approval to the building manufacturer to begin necessary engineering for the structural steel. We have also made the necessary down payment on that part of the project. In so doing, the building manufacturer has asked that we wait to pour the concrete foundation until they verify the column and footing locations.

We have spoken to our Architect and our Foundation Engineer and they have assured us they are in constant contact with the building manufacturer. As soon as the building manufacturer is far enough along with the plans, our Architect and Foundation Engineer will travel to the building manufacturer's office to work with them to ensure the necessary column and anchor bolt layouts are in place so we can begin framing and pouring the foundation.

And please keep in mind, we are fast approaching the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays when things tend to slow down even more. Be rest assured we are doing all we can to keep things on track.

Thank you for your patience with us and remember the day we move in, it will all be worth it.
