PERGAMUM BACKGROUND

- Referred to themselves as the "Greatest City in Asia Minor." They were also referred to as the "Religious Capital of Asia."
- Library with 200,000 volumes. Second only to the great Library in Alexandria.
- They had the first temple dedicated to Caesar.

CHURCH AT THYATIRA

Revelation 2:18-29

THYATIRA BACKGROUND

- Expendable military outpost.
- Famous for wool, linen, leatherwork, but mainly their bronze and purple dye.
- Daily life of the city was dominated by a network of trade guilds and labor unions that mixed their trade with pagan worship.
 - o Each had its own pagan deity, feasts, seasonal celebrations, etc....
- Considered the least important city of the seven cities.
- The church receives the longest letter from Jesus, even though the church was likely the smallest.

JESUS KNOWS THE TRUTH ABOUT THE CHURCH (v.18)

- "'The words of the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and whose feet are like burnished bronze."
 - O BLAZING EYES OF FIRE:

JESUS KNOWS WHAT A HEALTHY CHURCH LOOKS LIKE (v.19)

JESUS KNOWS WHEN THINGS ARE WRONG IN THE CHURCH (v.20)

- "THEY ALLOWED AN UNGODLY SPIRITUAL INFLUENCE IN THE LEADERSHIP OF THE CHURCH"
 - Jezebel (reference 1 Kings 16:29-33)
 - o How could a person like this gain influence in the church leadership?

JESUS CORRECTS THE CHURCH (v.21-23)

- Jesus brings His discipline.
 - o His discipline is:
 - FAIR (v.21)
 - FULL (v.22)
 - FINAL (v.23)
 - FEARFUL (v.23)
 - **FAITHFUL** (v.24-25)

JESUS ENCOURAGES THE CHURCH (v.24-29)
